Lifelong networking resource that is the only verified space to search for and connect with Columbia alumni across schools, degrees, graduation years, regions, interests, and more.

Dedicated LinkedIn Group for students and alumni of CSSW that provides a space for members to ask questions, find answers, post and view jobs, send messages^{*}, make new contacts, share knowledge and resources, and more.

- You can send <u>15 free 1:1 group messages</u> to fellow group members each month without being directly connected.
- <u>Columbia Alumni Association Network (#55739)</u> Alumni Only Similar to above but only open to alumni and includes graduates from the wider Columbia University network.
- <u>Columbia School of Social Work (CSSW) Alumni</u> List of CSSW graduates who have indicated "Columbia University - Columbia School of Social Work" as their alma mater on their profile.
 - You can identify alumni by where they live, where they work, what they do, what they studied, and what they're skilled at. Note that if you reach the <u>commercial use limit</u> for searching, your viewing options will be limited.
