GoinGlobal: A Tool for Finding “International-Friendly” Employers

As a CSSW student, you have a free subscription to GoinGlobal, a comprehensive, online career and employment resource that includes local and global career guides, worldwide job and internship opportunities, and lists of American employers that have hired international talent.

Click on the GoinGlobal icon on the [Career Connect](#) dashboard to access the site.



If you are an alum, you can access GoinGlobal by going to the Columbia Alumni Association’s [Career Resources](#) page. All you will need is your UNI to sign in.

Once you’re logged in, click on the H-1B Visas tab to research American employers seeking to hire international professionals through H-1B visa petitions. You can also identify positions, job locations, and salary ranges based on company name, occupation, industry, and job title.
