Professional Profile Pictures

When networking through social media it is important to present yourself in a professional manner.

Use a head shot

- Use a photo with your head and shoulders that highlights your face
- Do not use photos of you at parties, making weird faces, etc.

Your photo should be flattering

- Use a color photo
- Do not use artsy photos or glamour shots

Your face should be the focus, not the background

- Keep your face in focus; do not use blurry images
- Do not use photos with another person or object in the picture
- Other body parts (biceps, deltoids, cleavage, etc.) should be left unseen

Be fully-clothed

- Remember your profile picture is seen by everyone
- Do not use risqué photos

Do not make any funny faces

- A simple smile is best
- Do not frown, scowl, or use suggestive expressions

Keep your photo current

Make sure your photo actually looks like you

Find a photographer

- Pay or find a friend or student to take your photo
- Photo studios charge a small sitting fee
- Having a professional shot is worth the effort
- Do not use webcam shots or mirrored self-portraits
